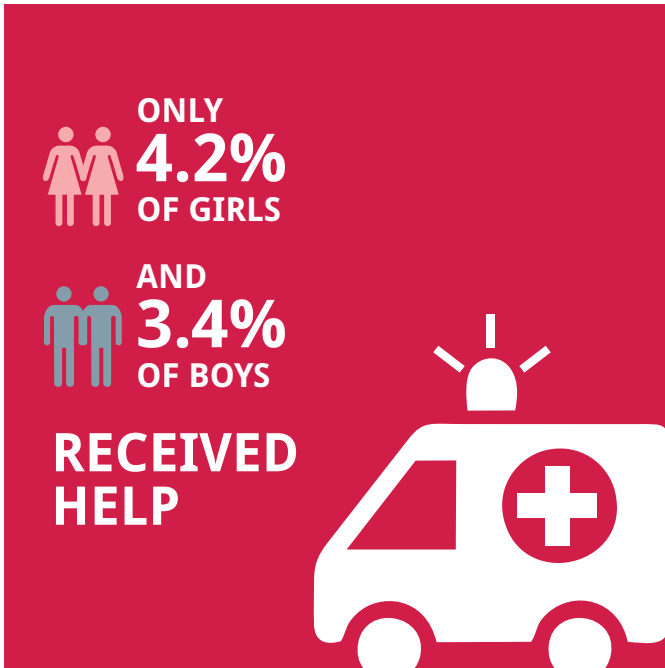
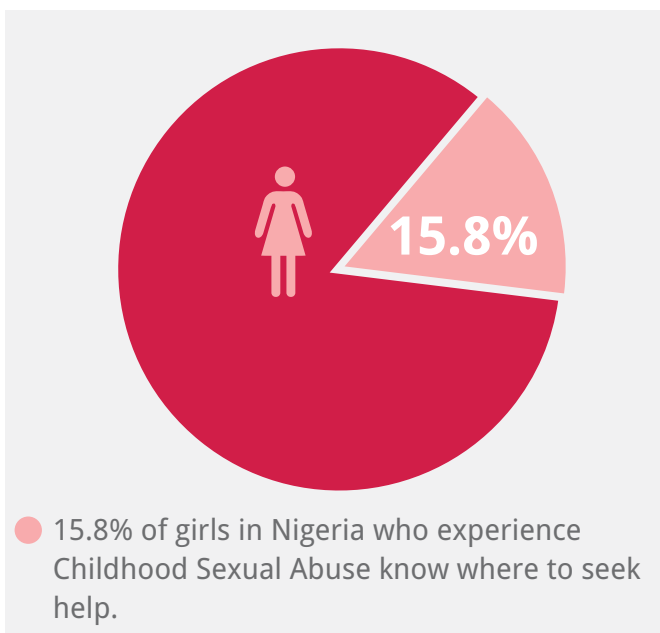


DISCLOSURE AND SERVICE-SEEKING BEHAVIOURS OF CHILDREN WHO HAVE EXPERIENCED **SEXUAL ABUSE.**



The main objective of this section is to describe the reporting and service seeking behaviours of females and males who experienced at least one incident of Sexual Abuse prior to age 18.

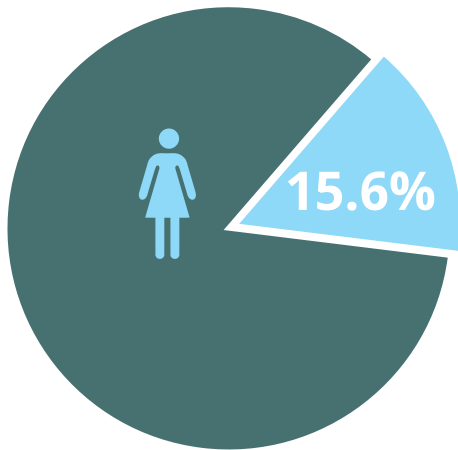


- 5% of girls who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse sought help.
- 2.6 % of boys who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse sought help.

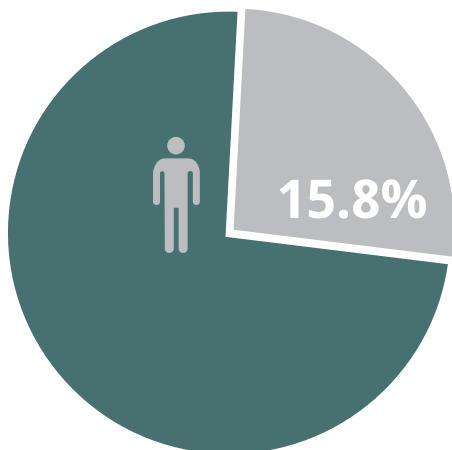
- 3.5% of girls who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse receive help.
- 1.5% of boys who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse receive help.

- 38.3% of girls told someone about an experience of sexual abuse.
- 26.9% of boys told someone about an experience of sexual abuse.

● 15.6% of girls in Nigeria who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse know where to seek help.



● 26.1% of boys in Nigeria who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse know where to seek help.



- 5.2% of girls who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse sought help.
- 3.4% of boys who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse sought help.

- 4.2% of girls who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse received help.
- 3.4% of boys who experience Childhood Sexual Abuse received help.

- 42.1% of girls told someone about an experience of sexual abuse.
- 34.2% of boys told someone about an experience of sexual abuse.
