📍 WHERE

- 1 in 5 cases of child sexual abuse occurs in the girl's home.
- 1 in 3 cases of sexual abuse occurs in the boy's home.

- 1 in 5 cases of child sexual abuse occurs in the perpetrator's home.
- 1 in 5 cases of sexual abuse occurs in the perpetrator's home.

- 1 in 7 cases of sexual abuse occurs in school.
- 1 in 4 cases of sexual abuse occurs in school.

🕒 WHEN

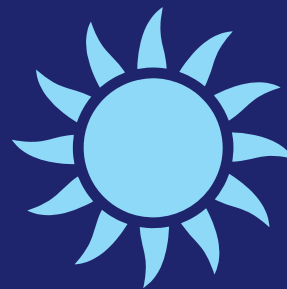
What period of the day have Nigerian children been sexually abused?

- 1 in 10 cases of sexual abuse occurs in the morning.
- 1 in 6 cases of sexual abuse occurs in the morning.

- Half of sexual abuse cases occurs in the afternoon.
- 1 in 2 cases of sexual abuse occurs in the afternoon.

- 1 in 2 cases of sexual abuse occurs in the evening.
- 1 in 3 cases of sexual abuse occurs in the evening.

- 1 in 5 cases of sexual abuse occurs in the mid night.
- 1 in 6 cases of sexual abuse occurs in the mid night.
