STEP 1: LEARN THE FACTS

1 in 4 girls and 1 in 10 boys will be sexually abused before the age 18.



STEP 2: minimize OPPORTUNITY

» **80** 0 of sexual abuse cases occur in isolated, one-one-one situations.

STEP 3: TALK ABOUT IT

children

Talk about safety, boundaries
and not keeping

secrets.

STEP 4: RECOGNIZE THE SIGNS

○ Often the sign are emotional or behavioral, not physical.
